NOTICE OF PROHIBITION

WHEREAS on or about March 5, 2018, Nita Rae Nirschl ("Nirschl") was sentenced on the charges of Embezzlement by a Credit Union Employee, 18 U.S.C. § 657, Money Laundering, 18 U.S.C. § 1957, and Attempt to Evade Tax, 26 U.S.C. § 7201, charges to which she previously pleaded guilty, in the U.S. District Court for the District of Kansas, in connection with her employment at Parsons Pittsburg Credit Union;

WHEREAS violations of 18 U.S.C. § 657, 1957 and 26 U.S.C. § 7201 are criminal offenses involving dishonesty and breach of trust;

NOW, THEREFORE, YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED THAT:

1. Pursuant to 12 U.S. C. § 1785(d)(1)(A) and 12 U.S.C. § 1829(a)(1)(A), Nirschl is prohibited from becoming an "institution affiliated party" of any insured depository institution, as defined in 12 U.S.C. § 1786(r); otherwise participating, directly or indirectly, in the conduct of the affairs of any insured depository institution; and owning or controlling, directly or indirectly, any insured depository institution;

2. Pursuant to 12 U.S. C. § 1785(d)(1)(B) and 12 U.S.C. § 1829(a)(1)(B), no insured depository institution may permit Nirschl to engage in any conduct or continue in any relationship prohibited in paragraph 1 above;

3. Pursuant to 12 U.S.C. § 1785(d)(3) and 12 U.S.C. § 1829(b), whoever knowingly violates paragraph 1 or 2 above is subject to a fine of not more than \$1 million for each day such prohibition is violated, or imprisonment for not more than five (5) years, or both;

4. The "Judgment In A Criminal Case" document, Case No. 6:17CR10052-001, is made a part hereof and is incorporated herein by reference; and
